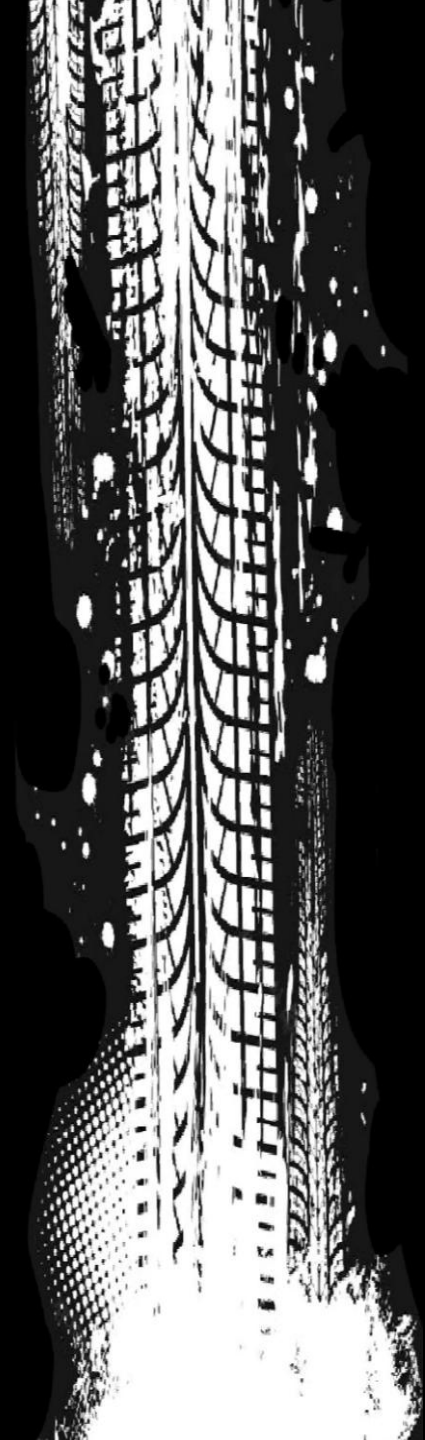

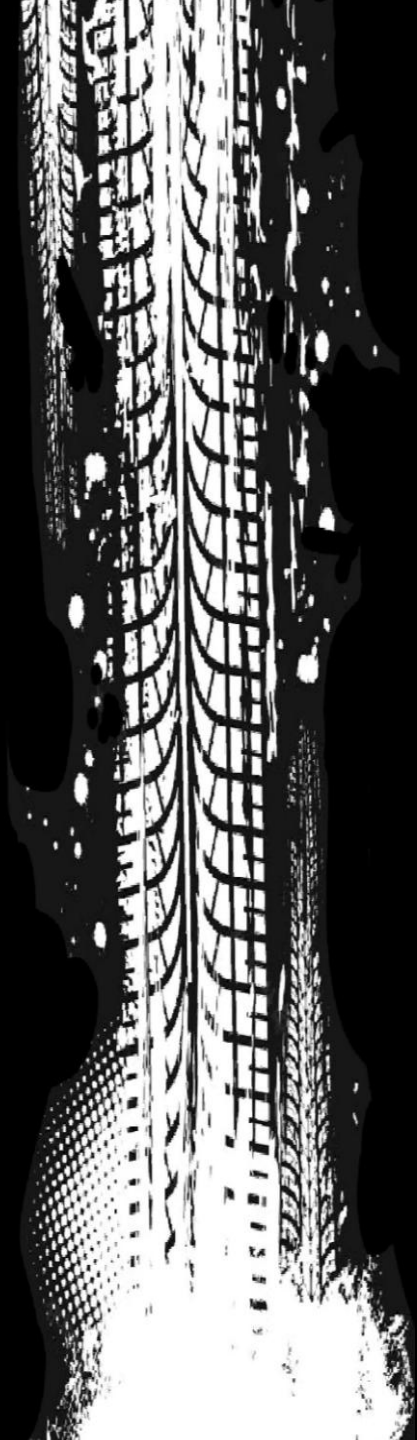

Registration & rules



Registration

All riders must enter through their National Federation;
No individual entries will be accepted.

The 2026 UCI BMX Racing World Cup offers entry into the combined Under 23 category for Junior and Under 23 riders, or the Elite category for riders aged 19 or over. Only riders holding a Junior, U23 or Elite license can participate at the UCI BMX Racing World Cup.

Registration **open May 14, 2026**
Deadline **close May 25, 2026**

Entry payments

The entry fee for the 2026 UCI BMX Racing World Cup is **€150** for the Under 23 category and **€250** for the Elite category.

In case of prepayment, the receipt must be taken to the rider confirmation.

The entry fee must be paid for all entries not withdrawn before the online registration deadline, whether the rider(s) concerned are confirmed or not by prepayment or at the rider confirmation.

Late registration

Late registration is only possible through the National Federation and must be completed prior to the end of rider confirmation on site which is on Thursday 4 June between 17.30 - 19.30.

The entry fee for late registration is **€300** for Under 23 and **€500** for elite and must be paid immediately on site.

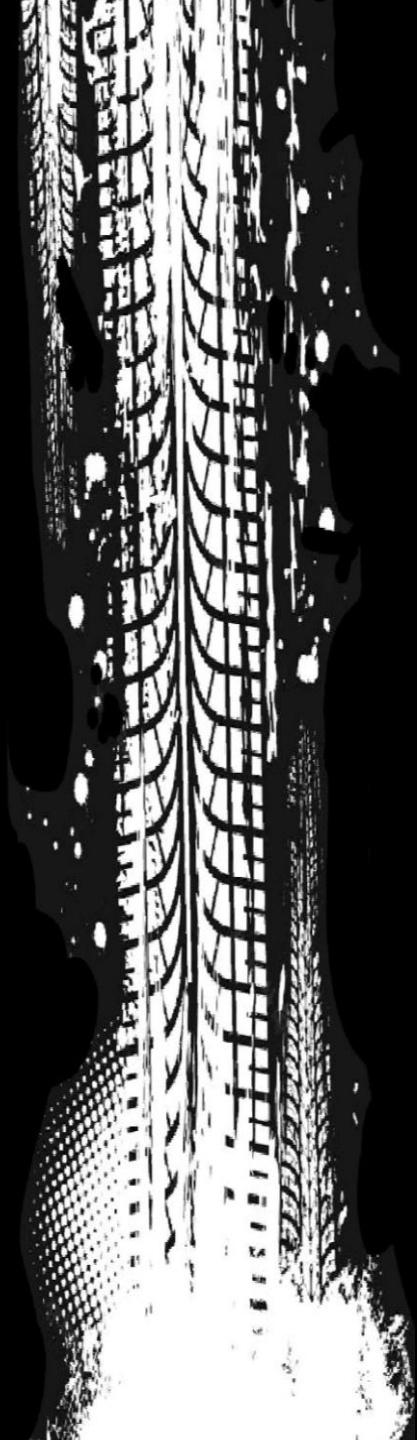

Rider's confirmation

Riders confirmation is on Thursday 4 June 2026 between 17.30 - 19.30 at Welcome center.

All Team Managers must attend the rider's confirmation, presenting their riders licenses and passport/ID cards, picking up their race numbers.

Riders not being confirmed before the deadline will not be able to compete at the event. Riders that were registered through the online system but that are unable to participate will still need to pay their entry fee to the organizer.

Team Staff accreditation

All rainbow passes are delivered to the teams during the first event of the year. If additional sporting passes are necessary, the request needs to be sent before the event to norm.mccann@uci.ch. Passes will be distributed during rider's confirmation in the registration room.

Rider's access

All athletes will be given a wristband so that they can access the venue and Team areas

Extra practice possibilities

Extra training days will be available at Sarrians's track. All participants of the 2026 UCI BMX Racing World Cup can reserve their spot for the trainings.

It's possible to book slots between May 19 and June 3 from 9am to 5pm.

Prize money will be paid in Euros, so please, fill in the google form when you have won prize money at [prize money UCI BMX World Cup Sarrians 2026](#)

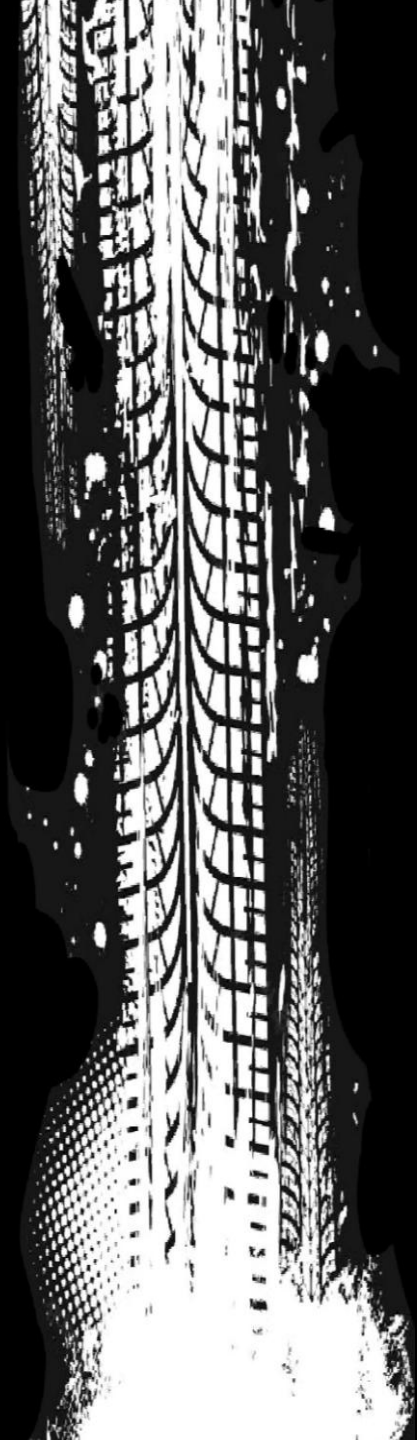

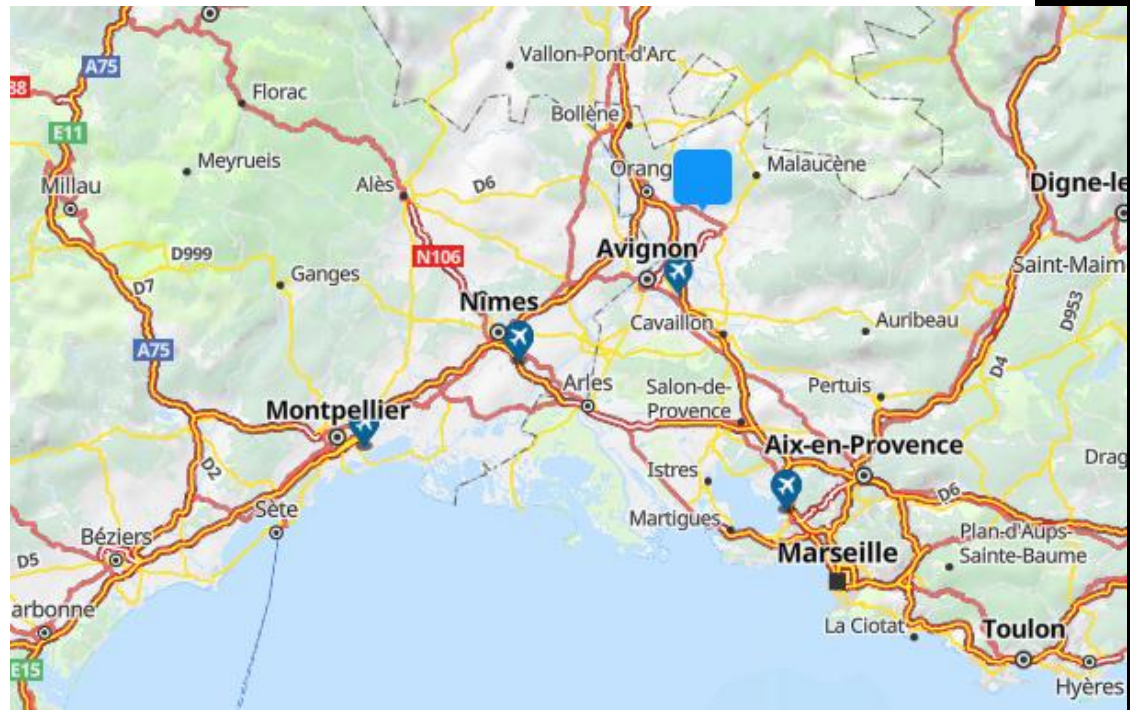

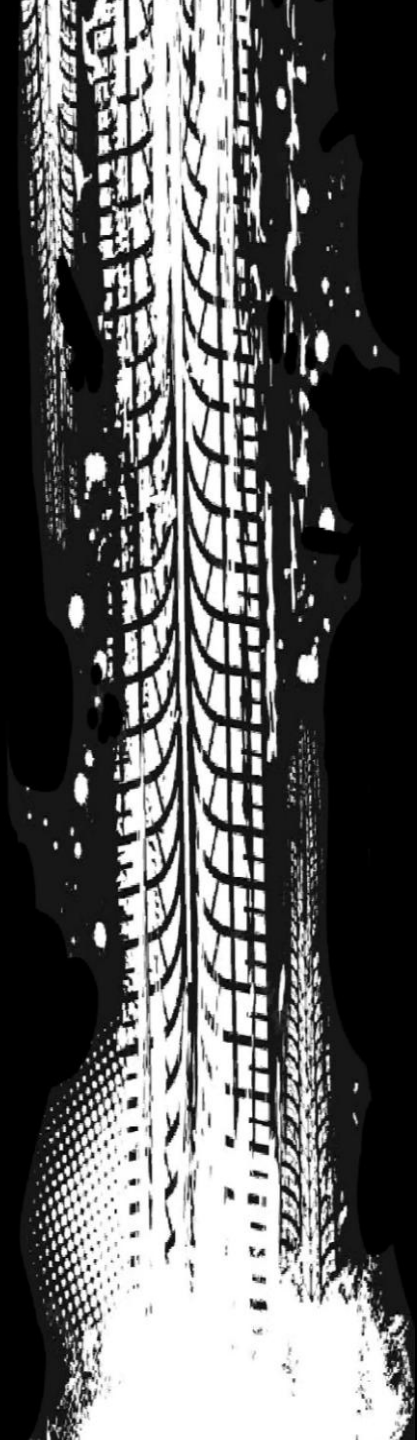

Team information



Team Bibs

Team Bibs will be provided for National Teams and UCI BMX Racing Teams during the rider confirmation. Teams will be asked to pay a **€100** deposit per bib.



The Team Bib gives access to allocated places explained by the PCP during the Team Managers meeting. The bibs need to be returned to the UCI Race Secretary at latest by the end of racing on Sunday June 7. Upon return of the bib the deposit will be refunded at that time.

Team areas

The team areas are situated at the left side of the track. Team areas are not accessible for cars.

Parking

Parking for teams and riders is possible in the car park for national teams. This parking is clearly indicated, and the car must display a parking card in the front window. You will receive the parking card at the riders conformation.

Team managers meeting

The Team Managers meeting will be held at 17.00 on Thursday, 4 June at welcome center.

Team area tents

All teams can rent a 4 x 4 meters tent in the team area. A table, 4 chairs and powerpoint are included.

Tent in the team area can be rented by teams for **€ 590,- (excl. VAT and service/ transaction costs)**. Also it is possible to rent more than one tent; they will be connected to create one large space.

PLEASE NOTE: spaces will be allocated on a first come, first serve base. Bookings cannot be cancelled.

Team Areas will be accessible from Friday 5 June 9am to Sunday 15 June 8pm.

The **drop-off** and the unloading of team equipment can only be on Thursday 4 June from 17.00 to 19.00 and Friday morning from 8.30 to 9.30.

Equipment removal can be done on Sunday 7 June, 30 minutes after the podium ceremonies have concluded. Every tent must be cleared out by teams before 20:00.

Medical Cover

A team of doctors and paramedics will be present throughout official practice (Monday June 1st to Wednesday June 3) and competition. The team will be based on the track and have use of a medical room near the exit of the track.

Be vigilant in case of extreme heat.

Be advised; when visiting the hospital you will need to bring; Copy of ID/Passport, address, postal code and place of residence. Copy of assurance / health care incl. phone number



Rider & Team Manager Seating

The team managers and riders have access to the seating area to watch the race. There is no reserved seating within the area. This will be accessed using an accreditation or wristband. There will also be an area for Team Managers trackside on the first straight.

Sarrians

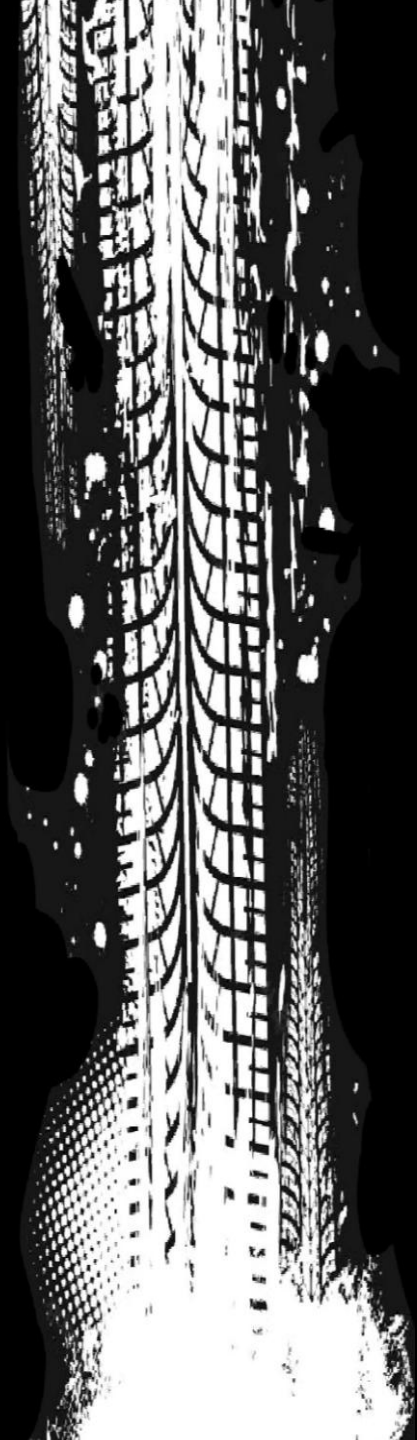
